

**St Andrew Square
Tram Works
7 January 2012 to December 2012**

On Saturday 7 January 2012, we will start preparing St Andrew Square for a programme of tram works. In advance of this enabling works will be taking place on the diversion route which will include lining, signing and signal works in the local area.

From 5am on Saturday 7 January all traffic will be diverted from North St Andrew Street, St Andrew Square East and South St Andrew Street.

Throughout this time all shops and businesses will remain open for business as usual.

Our worksite will be installed over the weekend of the 7 and 8 January 2012. The pedestrian footpaths will remain open at all times providing access to all shops and businesses. There will be crossing points installed at each end of the worksite together with a crossing point on both the southeast and northeast corners of St Andrew Square to allow pedestrians to cross over the carriageways. Crossing point will move location during the course of our works and directional signage will be installed and altered as necessary. A traffic lane will be available at all times for emergency services.

As a result of our works no on street deliveries will be available throughout the worksite area: therefore, we have organised a logistical support team to provide delivery support service to the local businesses on North St Andrew Street, St Andrew Square East and South St Andrew Street. The logistics team will be available during the hours of 6:30am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 6:30am to 1:00pm on Saturday. A member of the project team will be visiting local businesses starting this week to gain an understanding of individual logistical requirements.

Loading and unloading facilities will be available on South and North St Andrew Square and also on West Register Street with access and egress via Princes Street. The logistics facilities will be attended by logistics operatives during the aforementioned operational hours.

The attached schedule and map, details the associated traffic management changes in support of these works. Details about bus stop locations will be announced by Lothian Buses and other bus service providers in the coming weeks. We will also include this information in any future updates once it becomes available.

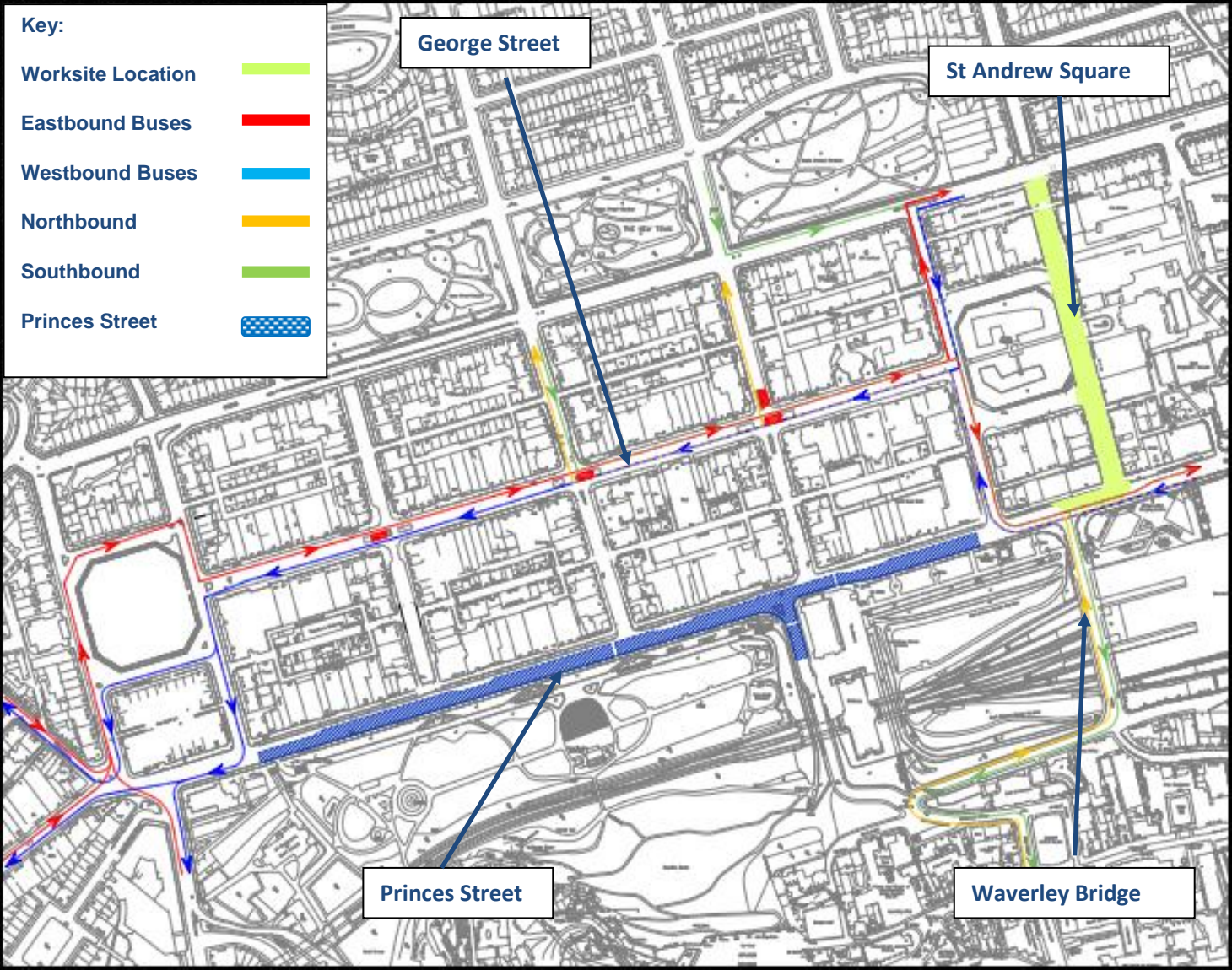

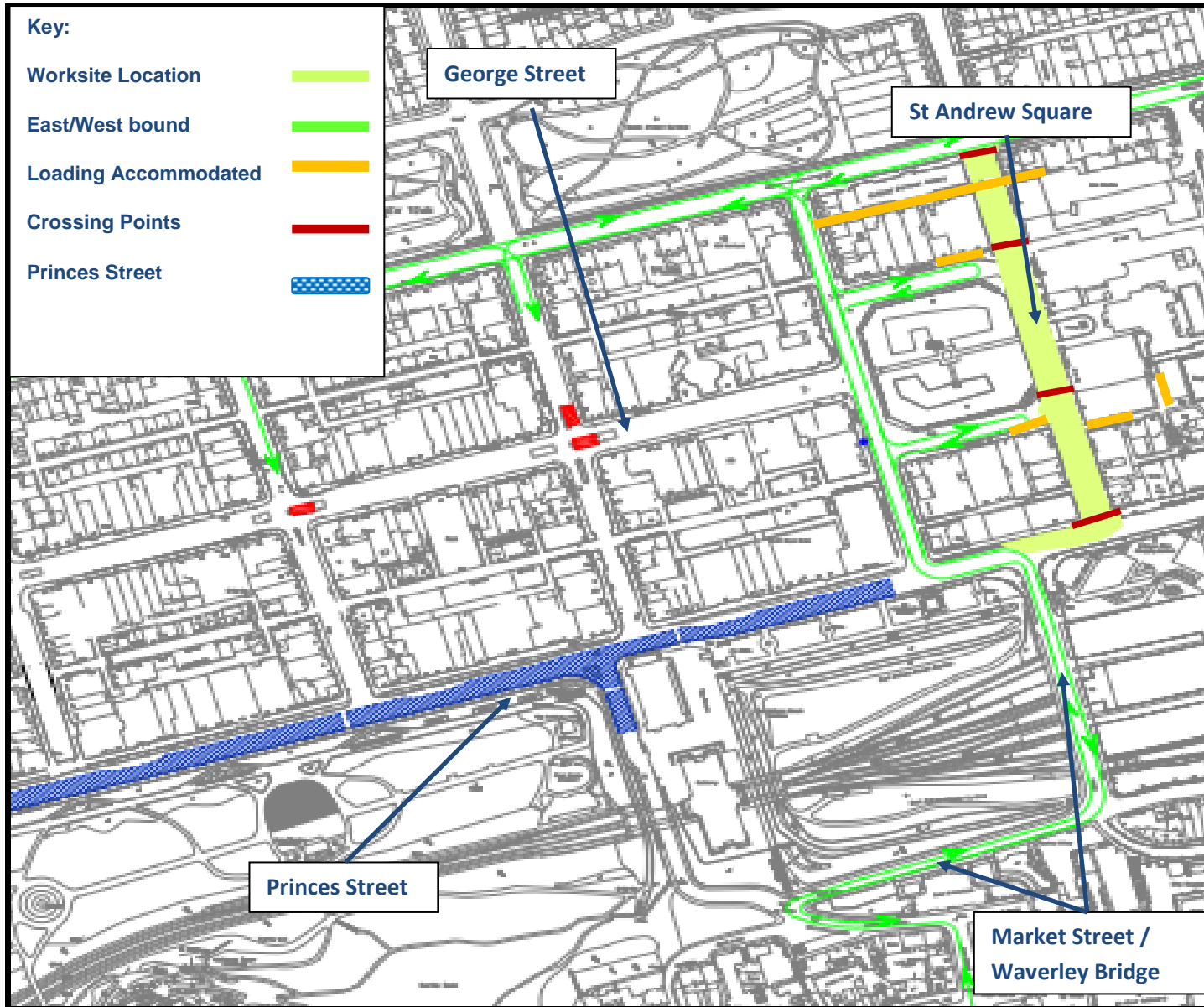
Public Transport Diversion Route
